EURYTHMIC WEEK

"Bodily movement is an experience felt by a sixth sense, the muscular sense. This consists of the relationship between the dynamics of movement and the position of the body in space, between the duration of movement and its extent, between the preparation of a movement and its performance." KG children experienced a series of movement based activities designed to develop the brain by exploring music. It embraced the body as a physical instrument of music, through exercises that created a heightened awareness of the body's responses to music as well as the body in physical space. It helped to explore these musical concepts: rhythm (the beat and the pattern), tempo (the speed of the rhythm), pitch (quality of sound as relates to its frequency, on a range of high-to-low), tone (the shape of the sound), volume (the loudness of the sound).



ASSEMBLY PEOPLE IN NEIGHBOURHOOD

The Assembly started with a warm up exercise by MS. Ameya. Prayer (Surah Fathiha) along with its translation was recited by MS. Fathima and MS. Aina respectively. Command Flag salute was given by MS. CREATIVE HAT COMPETITION

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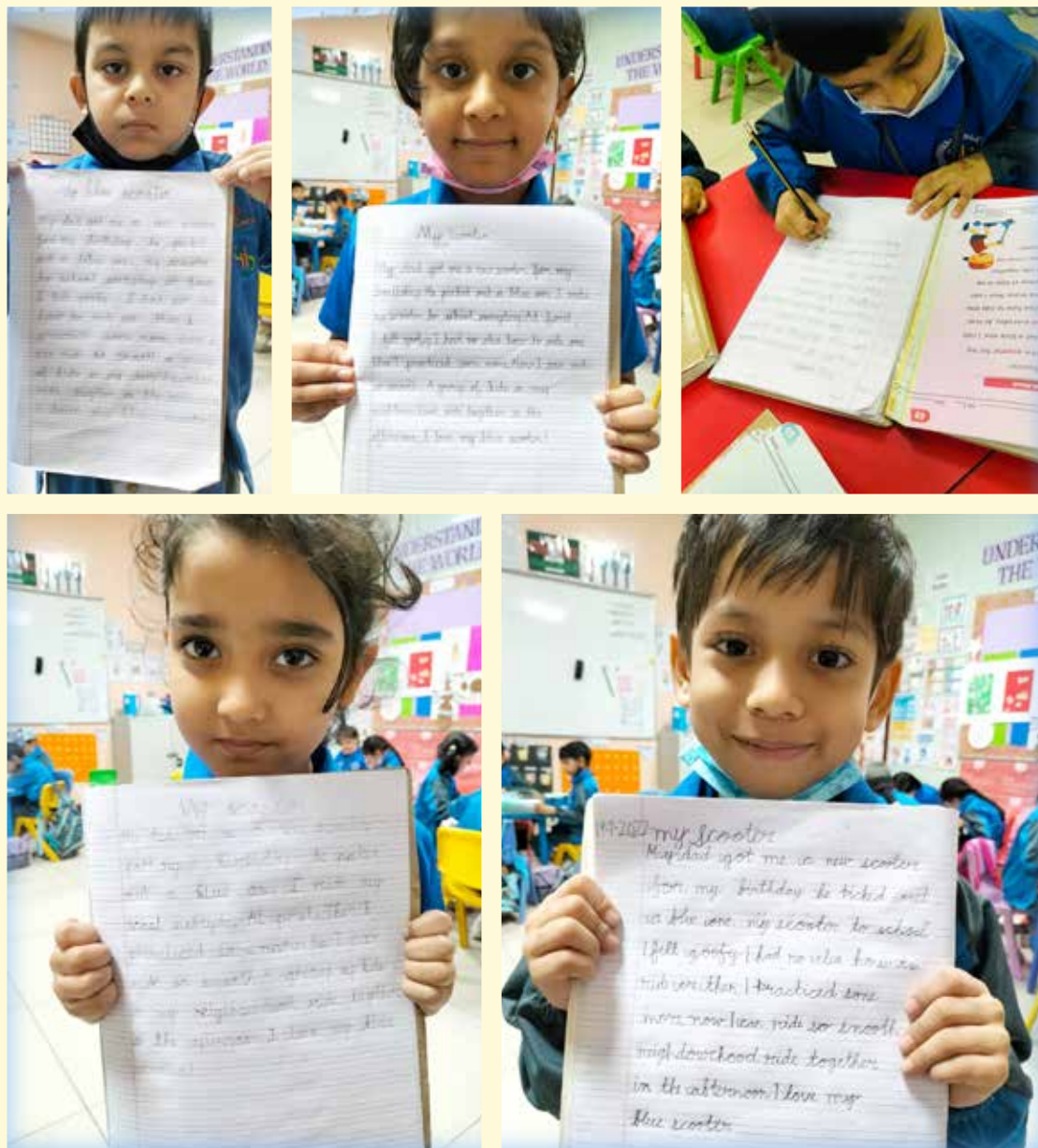
COMMUNITY HELPERS – ASSEMBLY

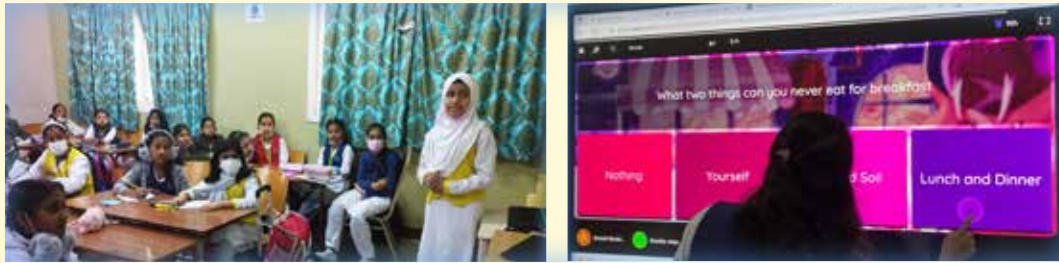
D.E.A.R ACTIVITY
